BioEnterprise is a business acceleration initiative to support the growth of bioscience companies. Since 2002, it has helped more than 80 Cleveland companies that have collectively attracted more than \$850 million in new funding. Prior to BioEnterprise, Shah was with McKinsey & Company, where he played a leading role in the Growth and Business Building practice. In the community, Shah serves on the Governor's Biomedical, Strategic Development, and Workforce Policy Advisory Boards, as well as the Boards of The Saint Luke's Foundation, Great Lakes Science Center, and the Yale Alumni Association. He is also the Founder and Chair of TiE-Ohio and Summer on the Cuyahoga. Shah has been named an Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year and has been recognized as one of Cleveland's most powerful and influential leaders by several publications.
