Baiju R. Shah is President and CEO and a Founder of BioEnterprise, a partnership of Case Western, Cleveland Clinic, Summa Health, and University Hospitals. BioEnterprise is a business acceleration initiative to support the growth of bioscience companies. Since 2002, it has helped more than 100 Cleveland companies that have collectively attracted more than \$1 Billion in new funding. Shah serves on the Board of Invacare (NYSE: IVC) and on the advisory boards of Charter One and Cleveland International Fund. Prior to BioEnterprise, Shah was with McKinsey & Company, where he played a leading role in the Growth and Business Building practice. In the community, Shah is Chair of Global Cleveland and also serves on the Boards of Great Lakes Science Center, Saint Luke's Foundation, United Way of Greater Cleveland, and Sustainable Cleveland 2019. He has also served as the founder and Chair of TiE (The International Entrepreneurs) Ohio and Summer on the Cuyahoga.
