

**Neuros Medical Wins \$1.5M Award From Department Of Defense**

Cleveland -- Medical device company Neuros Medical Inc. said it has received a \$1.5 million award from the U.S. Department of Defense.

The Applied Research and Technology Development Award will help Neuros Medical develop its neurostimulation therapy, called Nerve Block, to treat chronic residual limb pain suffered by amputees. The company's technology uses high frequency alternating current stimulation to block chronic pain signals in the peripheral nervous system.

Neuros Medical said military casualties and amputations experienced by those serving in Iraq and Afghanistan have contributed to the need to develop these treatments.

Founded in October 2008, Cleveland-based Neuros Medical has raised a total of \$2.2 million - \$375,000 in seed funding from JumpStart and Case Technology Ventures in March 2009, and \$1.8 million from investors including North Coast Angel Fund during its first round of funding in October 2009.
