Survey: A healthy environment for investors

If you had a spare \$1 million and wanted to invest it in a health-care start-up in the Midwest, where should you look?

According to a survey by the Midwest Healthcare Venture Report, the cities with the highest reputations among venture investors for the quality of health-care deals are Minneapolis, Cleveland and Pittsburgh.

Indianapolis, Cincinnati and Columbus, which ranked in the middle, showed notable gains. Chicago and St. Louis suffered significant losses in reputation, said the report, issued by **BioEnterprise**, a bioscience company developer based in (ahem) Cleveland.
