Mr. Sells graduated from Harvard Business School *with distinction* and joined Cole National a \$600 million company and rose to President and COO. In 1983 Mr. Sells joined Dayton Hudson Corporation and held positions of Vice Chairman, President, Member of the Board, and eventually COO of the \$10 billion corporation. In 1987 Mr. Sells joined Revco Drug Stores as Chairman, President and CEO. He is credited with turning Revco around and with its successful emergence from bankruptcy in 1992. Mr. Sells is also credited as a board member guiding the 2003 successful turn around and sale of NCS Healthcare. He continues to assist small to medium-sized companies and is active in civic and charitable organizations in the Cleveland area.

Mr. Cirino earned his MBA from Lake Erie College and has held marketing and management positions with Bailey Controls, Reliance Electric Company and Allen-Bradley. In 1984 he joined The Picker Corporation and held positions of Director - Corporate Marketing Services, VP Marketing - Health Care Products Division and President - Global Health Care Products Business, a \$500 million diagnostic imaging equipment, supplies and services business. In 1999 Mr. Cirino was promoted to Executive VP - Marconi Medical Systems (formerly Picker Corporation) and was elected to the Board of Directors. In 2002 he teamed with Platinum Equity Partners to acquire Diagnostic Imaging Inc. and Phillips Health Care Products and formed SourceOne Health Technologies becoming the President and CEO of the \$1.2 billion company. Three years later, he engineered the sale of the company to a strategic buyer. Currently, Mr. Cirino is the President and CEO of Imalux Corporation, a progressive biomedical imaging company located in Cleveland, Ohio.
