Morgan Foundation makes free enterprise grants

Trustees of the Burton D. Morgan Foundation in Hudson have approved more than \$1 million in grants to promote free enterprise.

JumpStart Inc., Northeast Ohio's venture development organization will receive \$350,000, and BioEnterprise, the region's health care business developer, \$250,000.

Other Northeast Ohio institutions receiving grants: Boys & Girls Clubs of Cleveland, \$28,000; E City, \$31,000; Great Trail Council, Boy Scouts of America, \$90,000; Junior Achievement of Greater Cleveland Inc., \$31,500; and Junior Achievement of Lorain County, \$15,600.

In addition, Laurel Lake Retirement Community Foundation will receive, \$25,900; National Inventors Hall of Fame, \$70,400; Summit (County) Education Initiative, \$9,700; University School, \$28,400; and United Way of Summit County, \$50,000.
